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



## Bard vs. ChatGPT (Generative AI)

#### **Data Sources:**


- Bard is trained on a massive dataset of text & code which includes information from the internet.
- ChatGPT is trained on a pre-defined set of data that has not been updated since September 2021 which means it cannot provide up-to-date data.

#### **Internet Access:**

- Bard has real-time access to the internet, which means it can craft responses from real time information. It has search capability and is best for current information, market data and forecasts.
- ChatGPT does not have access to the internet. This
  means that ChatGPT can only craft responses from
  the data that it was trained on. In the paid version,
  you can add plugins that bring it current.

#### Cost:

- Bard is free as of now
- ChatGPT has a free and a paid version



# Some Uses Bard & ChatGPT

- Answer questions
- Generate text
- Translate languages
- Write creative content
- Brainstorm ideas
- Outline documents
- Generate keywords for SEO optimization
- Course and curriculum creation
- Collaborate
- Write/debug code
- Revise/organize/compile/clean up data
- Synthesize/analyze/interpret data (input or from a link) & make recommendations based on data

# Warp Speed

- Saves Time
- Provides Answers Quickly
- Helps Draft
- Gives you Direction
- Supports you at Work & Personal
- Refine Responses
  - tweak & optimize by weaving in your own expertise, personal touch, additional prompts
- Use Prompts that help it write in your own style (serious, conversational, etc.)

It misunderstands your prompt and generates something unrelated to what you really want




# Prompt Engineering



### How to Use

#### Maximize Interface & Results


- Ask it questions
- Give it directions to write something personal or business
- Use to generate business documents (i.e. reports, keynote presentations, investor decks, agendas)
- Use it to edit documents
- Use it for research
- Correct & continue
  - If you don't get the response you're looking for, revise and refine your prompt
- Edit your documents to make them more concise and focused
- Current news/developments/search/compare (on Bard)




# Chat & Prompt Plain English


- ChatGPT & Bard both accept prompts in plain English
- You can ask questions & chat without knowing code
- Casual prompts like you are chatting with a friend, employee, assistant, business representative, customer service bot
- Give it parameters & specific directions to get good responses
- You can use it to overcome a creative block
- If you're not clear on what you want, you can use it to learn about topics & then refine your prompts with that knowledge
- Tailor prompts to your specific needs
- Give it as much guidance as you would if you were giving someone an assignment & explaining exactly what they have to do

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## Writing Prompts

#### Be Specific & Tailor to Needs/Task

- Provide context
- Give it as much information upfront as you can
- Tailor it to your specific needs
- Revise with further prompt instructions after each response until you are satisfied
- Tell it the length of the response (i.e. one page article, 10 tips, 500 words.10 slides)
- Tell it the style (i.e. concise bullet points, short paragraphs with headings and subheadings, use statistics, vignettes, personal experiences, perspective, serious, funny or casual, etc.)
- Provide the format (i.e. investor deck, keynote presentation, blog, script, code, social media post, app code, game code, etc.)





## Sample Prompts

#### Prompt 1

Write a blog article about 5 ways to stand out from the competition in the job market, using concise short sentences, bullet points, headings and subheadings, with hypothetical scenarios and a bit of humor.

#### Prompt 2


Add common mistakes and mishaps and keep entire article to 1000 words.

#### **Prompt 3**

Make it more concise and use statistics on what employers are looking, delete [XYZ] and [ABC] references and replace with researching your interviewer ahead of time and finding common ground to talk about, and wish readers good luck at the end of the blog, take a more serious tone and make it less cheeky humor.





- Write an [entertaining][serious] article with concise bullet points, [funny vignettes] [statistics] about [insert topic]
- Revise to make it shorter
- Add a topic about [\_\_\_\_]
- Provide sources for the data







## Limitation: Al Sometimes Hallucinates

- Al makes up facts that are not true
- Al doesn't know if what it says is right or wrong
- That's where you come in







## Limitation: Intellectual Property Issue



- On March 16, 2023, the U.S. Copyright Office launched a New Artificial Intelligence Initiative with copyright guidelines for works containing Al-generated material. It issued a Statement of Policy on whether works consisting of both human-authored and Al-generated material may be copyrighted and is proceeding on a case-by-case basis. 

- You can upload documents or provide links for AI to analyze which helps address the quality of information issue
- Fact Check & Research
- Can always add more prompts
  - narrow, refine, redefine, edit and Al gives new answers with those additional prompts and directions



- Synthesize and analyze data from [link], identify trends, patterns and inconsistencies, and make recommendations based on the data.
- What are the problems facing XYZ company and how would you solve them?
- Write a report about ABC industry with research data and statistics
- What is the global market revenue for the ABC industry?
- What is the growth rate of ABC industry over 5-10 years?
- How many daily active users does XYZ website have?
- You are a working woman struggling with XYZ problem, what would you want in an [ABC product/service] that addresses your problem?



#### Sample Prompt

Write a market slide for an investor deck on a healthy eating app, with statistics on the global health market, healthy eating app market, target audience for healthy eating apps, growth rate over the next 5-10 years, and 10 leading competitors, include sources of data

#### Tips:


- Because you are asking for statistics and data, it's best to use BARD since it has real time information and can give you up to date information and forecasts.
- Always check your data. Don't assume it's correct. Remember, Al hallucinates.
- Always ask for sources for the data to make it easier to fact check and to add those sources into the investor slide if they are accurate [i.e. According to a 2022 survey by XYZ Source .....]








# Al Game Code Generation Use Al as a Starting Point

#### **Sample Prompt**

Generate code for an online adventure game in the wilderness where two contestants race to avoid obstacles, flying objects and dangerous beasts until they get to a rickety bridge and cross safely to the other side without falling off.

Bard & ChatGPT will both generate code but there are differences when you do a comparison of the two.

It is just a starting point. The next step is to develop the code and tweak it.




## Social Media Post Prompt

Write a concise inspiring social media post about success, 1 sentence with emojis

One Al generated a post that was a famous author quote in text without quote marks and without the author's name.

If you use that quote, you need to attribute the quote to the author but you might not know that it's someone else's quote. So you need to verify and check Al's work.


